

Dress Code and School Uniform Policy for 2021-2022

Updated July 12, 2021

A school dress code is important to a school’s program. It not only helps set a “standard appearance” for a school, but it can also influence the behavioral and educational environment and on the public’s perception of the school. All students in grades K4 – 5 are expected daily to wear the correct school uniform as outlined below.

It is the desire of Cornerstone Schools of Alabama that our students live and conduct themselves in a manner that will be pleasing to God and glorifying to the name of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Standards for appearance are a means of building character and distinction in the lives of our students.
